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Sitemap plugin

Exposes a single endpoint, GET `/sitemap.xml`, listing every **indexable** item across every content plugin (Academy, Blog, Docs, FAQ, Pages) — for search engine crawlers, not for AI agents (that's [MCP](#)) nor for an indexing pipeline (that's [API](#)). Deliberately does not emit `<changefreq>`/`<priority>`: modern crawlers (Google included) ignore both, so there is nothing to configure there.
